


Step by Step Instructions

Step 1 – Course Selection and Payment

Upon completing your profile details click on "Training Library" (Red Circle)

This will take you to the course landing page, select the Course Category for the Course you wish to enrol in (Blue Circles)


This will take you to the payment page.




Step 2 - Pre-Course work


Once you have entered the course bundle, select "Start" (Red Circle)









Step 3 - Course work

You should see "TFA Foundation Coach" (Blue Circle). Click on "View" (Black Circle)




Once you entered that training "Bundle" you will need to progress through each of the online theory modules. Module 1 (Blue circle) should be completed first








Module 2 (Black circle) should be completed second
